  - Short Course (4km) 2 Laps (no portages)
- Classes:
  - o K1, K2, C1, C2, and GP classes available.
- Race numbers will be provided. £5 fee for loss/damage.

- All participants must wear buoyancy aids.
- Suitable clothing and footwear are required.
- First aid is available on-site.
