- REFRESHMENTS** Light refreshments for competitors after their race. Drinks and snacks available to purchase throughout the day.
- SAFETY** The provisions of 'Rule 5 - Safety' apply. All division 7 – 9 and GSA - GSC **must wear** approved buoyancy aids. All paddlers under 16 years of age in higher divisions are strongly advised to do so. For the Bedford Hasler higher ranking paddlers in division 7 K2 **must wear** an approved buoyancy aid. All boats must carry sufficient buoyancy to remain afloat and support their crew in the event of a capsiz. Changing and shower facilities will be available at the Viking Kayak Club boathouse on the 1st floor.
- PARTICIPATION** **Canoeing and Kayaking is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. Participants should be aware of and accept these risks, and be responsible for their own action and involvement.**
- PRIZES** 1st, 2nd & 3rd Paddler/Crew in each singles and doubles Hasler division will receive prizes provided there is quorate entry in division.

NUMBERS	Vertical numbers for marathon racing are compulsory for div 1 - 9. Regional number boards will be provided for the Hasler race. Lost boards will be charged at £5 each so please make sure they are fixed securely.
FEES	Senior: £10.00 per seat, Junior: £8.00 per seat, Div A-C, GSK2: £4.00 per seat. GSK2 race entry is free for GSA-GSC paddlers. Late entries accepted on Sat 29th Apr until 8pm - £5.00 extra per seat. Event Ticket £5.00 per paddler - required for paddlers who cannot prove they have valid British Canoeing On The Water membership or Club Associate membership. For divisions 1 to 6 an event ticket may only be purchased if a competitor has not raced in the last 5 years. An event ticket only provides temporary insurance cover to take part in a single event and is not a “day membership” or boat license for the use of waterways
RULES	The race will be run in accordance with the current British Canoeing Marathon Racing Committee Rules.
BRITISH CANOEING MEMBERSHIP	Competitors must be current On The Water members of British Canoeing, Canoe England, WCA, SCA, CANI or for Div 7,9, GSA-GSC have had their club membership registered with British Canoeing as an Associate Member . Competitors without proof of membership may be able to purchase an Event Ticket – see FEES above.
ENTRIES	All entries together with the correct fees payable to Viking Kayak Club must be received by 8pm Sat 29th April 2023 . Please use the British Canoeing Race Entry website for entries https://entries.gbcanoemarathon.co.uk/entries Where this is not possible an individual entry form is available at the end of this pack. Single C1 SUP entries will be accepted (propelled by a single paddle).

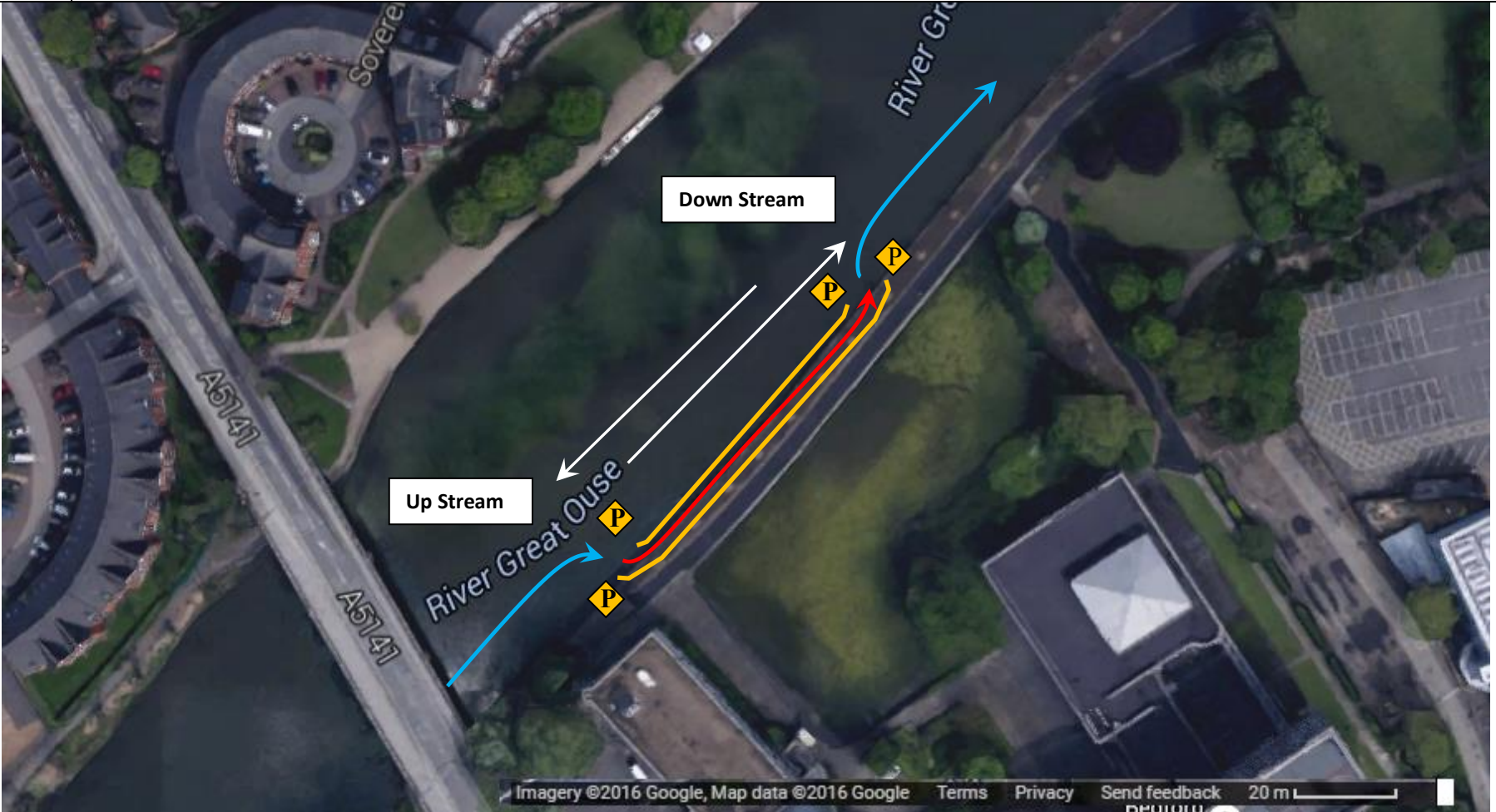

19.7 km Course 4 portages, 10 turns	(Start/Finish – Turn A – Turn B – Portage – Start/Finish = 4.3 km lap) x 1 laps + (Start/Finish – Turn A – Turn B – Portage – Start/Finish = 4.3 km lap) x 3 laps + (Start/Finish – Turn A – Turn C – Start/Finish = 2.5 km lap) x 1 lap
12.9 km Course 2 portages, 6 turns	(Start/Finish – Turn A – Turn B – Portage – Start/Finish = 4.3 km lap) x 1 laps + Start/Finish – Turn A – Turn B – Portage – Start/Finish = 4.3 km lap) x 1 laps + Start/Finish – Turn A – Turn B – Start/Finish = 4.3 km lap) x 1 laps
6.8 km Course 0 portages, 4 turns	(Start/Finish – Turn A – Turn B - Start/Finish = 4.3 km lap) x 1 lap + (Start/Finish – Turn A – Turn C - Start/Finish = 2.5 km lap) x 1 lap
2.5 km Course 0 portages, 2 turns	Start – Turn A – Turn C - Finish





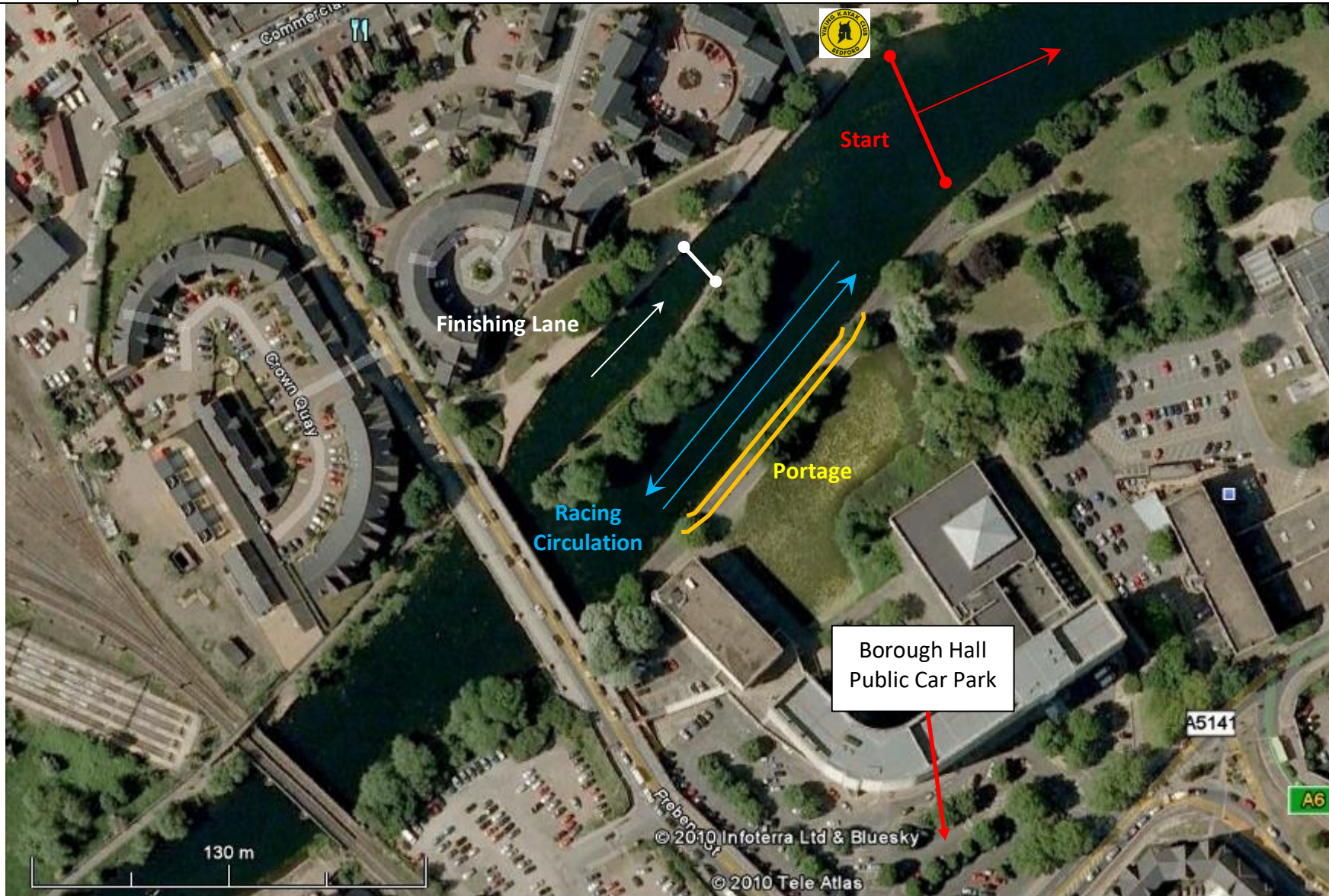
