The provisions of 'Rule 5 - Safety' apply. All division 7-9 and GSA - GSC **must wear** approved buoyancy aids. All paddlers under 16 years of age in higher divisions are strongly advised to do so. For the Bedford Hasler higher ranking paddlers in division 7 K2 **must wear** an approved buoyancy aid. All boats must carry sufficient buoyancy to remain afloat and support their crew in the event of a capsize.

Changing and shower facilities will be available at the Viking Kayak Club

boathouse on the 1st floor.

PARTICIPATION

Canoeing and Kayaking is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. Participants should be aware of and accept these risks, and be responsible for their own action and involvement.

Late entries accepted on Sat 29th Apr until 8pm - £5.00 extra per seat. Event Ticket £5.00 per paddler - required for paddlers who cannot prove they have valid British Canoeing On The Water membership or Club

Associate membership.

For divisions 1 to 6 an event ticket may only be purchased if a competitor

has not raced in the last 5 years.

An event ticket only provides temporary insurance cover to take part in a single event and is not a "day membership" or boat license for the use of

waterways







Borough Hall Portage


